

Line-up Procedures for Regular Race Meets

Heat Races

- Heat race line-ups will be determined by a draw.
- The formula for determining the number of heat races will be as follows:

less than 8 cars – 1 heat

8-20 cars – 2 heats

21-30 cars – 3 heats

31-40 cars – 4 heats

41+ cars – 5 heats

Feature

- Feature race line-ups will be determined by heat race finishes or qualifying times if time trials are conducted. A roll of the dice will determine the invert.
- If there are fewer than 26 cars, all cars will run the feature event.
- When the car count reaches 26, the 18 top heat race finishers or qualifiers will be locked into the feature and the remainder will run the B-Main.
- The top 2 finishers in the B-Main will be added to the feature to make a 20 car starting field.
